

WHAT IS LENT?

We are now in the midst of Lent and many ask *what is Lent?* Lent is a time set aside to open the doors of our hearts a little wider and understand our Lord a little deeper, so that when Good Friday and eventually Easter comes, it is not just another day at church but an opportunity to receive the overflowing of graces God has to offer. It is the time of year, which we are reminded of what Jesus did for us. Christ's sacrifice and his subsequent resurrection are the true "cruxes" of the Christian faith. Without one there would be no salvation, without the other, no hope. We open our hearts to God's refining grace through prayer, confession of sins, fasting, and almsgiving as we anticipate Holy Week. Lent traditionally lasts forty days, modeled after Christ's forty day fast in the desert. The 40 days are set aside to really examine areas of recurring sin in our lives that prevent us from being conformed to God's Will. The goal is to honestly examine your life in light of God's Word and to make a commitment to change in any areas you have not submitted to the Lord.

"Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my thoughts. See if there is any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting." Psalm 139: 23-24

Prayer:

Prayer is our conversation with God. It is through prayer that we find the strength to fast or accomplish any goal we may have. It is through prayer that we develop a closer, more intimate relationship with God. This relationship makes us so grateful for the blessings he has bestowed upon us that we eagerly give to those less fortunate than us. Prayer is essential to any action we as Christians may undertake.

Fasting:

Fasting is a way of denying ourselves the excesses of life so that we might be more attuned to the Lord's voice. It is also a way of disciplining yourself, strengthening your "spiritual muscles" so to speak, so that when temptations arise in life, you are already used to saying "no" to our desires. And finally, fasting is also a way of participating, in a small way, in the sufferings of Christ and can be particularly powerful when accompanied by prayer and confession. When thinking of fasting always take into account any medical conditions or nutritional needs when deciding what and how much to abstain from (consulting with a doctor is recommended).

Charity/Almsgiving:


A very important element of the Lenten season is becoming aware of not only the suffering and sacrifice of Christ but also to the suffering of others. Between now and Good Friday, choose one way you can increase your giving to those in need. It could be through extra financial offerings, donating goods you no longer need or use to charity, or increasing your personal time commitment to a ministry or cause close to your heart.



God is good in ways beyond our knowledge. We don't always see the good that God is doing behind the scenes. Sometimes what appears as trouble is not trouble at all.

When is trouble not trouble you ask? When it protects us from an unknown hazard on the road ahead, or shelters us from a sin that, unknown to us, lurks in our path waiting to tempt and trip us. Here are some example for you to ponder.

Trouble is not trouble when...

- When it makes you clean up collected clutter that you valued too much and did not have the courage to discard or destroy
- When it tears out of your life an unworthy friend whom you were unable to help and who was not a good influence on your life
- When it makes you furious enough to fight for a good cause you were too busy to serve


